- If you are a current player you can register online now.
- If you have not played Australian Rules Football before you can register online now.
- If you have played Australian Rules Football before at another club, you
 will be required to complete a clearance. You will need to contact our
 Junior Football Director Mikael Urmersbach or by registering on PLAYHQ
 which will initiate the transfer.
- All fees are to be paid online when registering your child during the above process. Registration and payment <u>must be made prior to round 1</u> of the season.
- **This year Play HQ** have introduced a new flexible payment system with PAYPAL enabling payment over 4 instalments.
- DO NOT give any fees to Coaches or Team Managers as they can't issue receipts. All players must be financial members of South Gawler Football Club for eligibility to be picked to play.

All players must provide their Medical Information, so that coaches are aware of those who have health issues (eg asthma, diabetics, anaphylaxis, etc) and be prepared for an emergency. All player information is held in confidence.

MOUTHGUARDS - Compulsory

Mouthguards must be worn by all grades.

INJURIES

All injuries are to be reported to the Trainers immediately at training and on gameday. All players are to adhere to trainer's instructions.

Parents who are able to assist as a Trainer for the season are to contact the club ASAP. We value your help in this role. Trainer courses are subsidised by club.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECKS

A WWCC is required by any person volunteering with underage players, such as a coach, team manager, trainer etc. A WWCC can be obtained by contacting Jenny Judd-Smith (committee member) via the South Gawler Football Cub Facebook Messenger page or via email to committee@southgawlerfc.com There is no cost to apply as a volunteer.

CHILD PROTECTON

The South Gawler Football Club is committed to the safety and wellbeing of all children and young person's accessing our service. We support the rights of the child and will act without hesitation to ensure a child safe environment is maintained at all times. We also support the rights and well-being of our staff and volunteers and encourage their active participation in building and maintaining a secure environment for all participants.

TAKING IMAGES OF CHILDREN

The South Gawler Football Club acknowledges that in South Australia under the Summary Offences Act 1953 a person must not engage in indecent filming. Images of children and adults should not be used inappropriately or illegally.

Our club requires that members, wherever possible, obtain permission from a child's parent/guardian before taking an image of a child that is not their own and ensure that the parent knows the way the image will be used. Our club also requires the privacy of others to be respected and disallows the use of

camera phones, videos and cameras inside changing areas, showers and toilets. Photographs taken with permission are not to be offered for sale or financial gain at our Club. The Club will engage the services of a Professional team photographer for this purpose.

If the club uses an image of a child it will avoid naming or identifying the child or it will, wherever possible, avoid using both the first name and surname.

We will not display personal information such as residential address, email address or telephone numbers without gaining consent from the parent/guardian. We will not display information about hobbies, likes/dislikes, school, etc as this information can be used as grooming tools by pedophiles or other persons. We will only use appropriate images of a child, relevant to our sport and ensure that the child is suitably clothed in a manner that promotes the sport, displays its successes, etc.

SOCIAL MEDIA - i.e. FACEBOOK

Your actions on social media may have serious consequences. Negative comments and images, bullying, criticism and sexist, racist or derogatory remarks not only impact negatively on the people they are about, they reflect badly on yourself, your parents and the people you represent. If you are found to have acted improperly on social media, the club may ask to explain your actions and disciplinary action may be imposed such as suspension or cease of membership from the club. **This applies to Players and Parents**. The club Facebook page is primarily for information of events, functions etc. It is not a platform for negativity towards the club or its members. Do not "share" inappropriate matter on our FB page, remember you are all ambassadors of South Gawler Football Club at the club or in Public.

Code of Conduct

Players & Parents/Guardians Role.

Players:

Play by the rules: they are there for the good of all.

Never argue with an official: if you disagree, discuss the matter with your coach or team manager after the game.

Control your temper: verbal abuse, racial or religious vilification of other players, and provoking an opponent or the other team are never appropriate.

Be a good sport: applaud all good plays by your team, opponent or the opposition team.

Treat all players fairly: treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.

Cooperate willingly: cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no game.

Play for fun: Play for the 'fun of it' and not just to please parents and coaches.

Parents/Spectators: -

Remember children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.

Encourage children to participate, do not force participation upon them.

Focus on your children's efforts and self-esteem rather than whether they win or lose.

Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.

Never ridicule or yell at children for making a mistake or if their team loses a game.

Remember children learn best by example – applaud the efforts of all players in both teams.

Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.

Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators – without whom your child could not participate.

Respect umpires' decisions and teach children to do likewise.

Remember smoking and the consumption of alcohol is unacceptable at junior sport.

Players in U9, U11 & U13 must have a parent/guardian present at all times.

PLAYER CONDUCT

Players should always be aware that they are representing the **South Gawler Football Club** and should conduct themselves in the proper and correct manner, this is both on and off the field.

The Disciplinary Policy & Procedures document is located on our website. This provides a uniform approach to the handling of any on or off field breaches or behaviour of any player, coach, club official, parent, supporter, and club member.

SPECTATORS INSIDE BOUNDARY FENCE PERIMETER

We as a club have a duty of care to ensure that spectators do not sit on the inside of the boundary fence (and in particular the use of deck chairs) as this places a player's safety in question. Although Field Umpires have the right to 'stop/start' play when they observe this type of infringement, we need to ensure that spectators do not encroach over the fence line whilst a match is in progress.

GAME DAY – COACHING AREA

No unauthorised persons allowed within the coach's box, or within the marked area around the coaching area. No coaching from sidelines and parents are not to approach players at breaks and "coach". Enjoy watching your child and leave the coaching to the assigned Coach/es.

ALCOHOL / DRUGS

South Gawler Football Club will <u>not</u> tolerate any underage consumption of alcohol by any player or taking or providing illegal drugs.

Parents and caregivers are also reminded that <u>no alcohol</u> is to be brought into the grounds on game days/nights. Our liquor licence has strict rules in regard to alcohol within our premises and grounds. Our licenced Bars on game days/nights shall be able to provide adults with refreshments should they wish to partake.

Please respect our ruling on this matter.

SECURITY

Players should report any lost property to their Team Manager immediately. Players should not leave valuables in the change rooms. They can be left with the Team Manager or preferably left with parents/caregivers prior to going to change rooms. The South Gawler Football Club accepts no responsibility for lost items. Unclaimed clothing left at clubrooms shall be donated to local charities if left at club for months at end. It is your responsibility to remember to collect any jumpers, clothing that you own.

COVID SAFE CLUB

We are a Covid Safe Compliant Club. Please adhere to SA Health directions and social distancing regulations when enforced.

SATURDAY NIGHT AWARDS

All under 13,15,17 ½ players are encouraged to attend the Football clubrooms on Saturday nights for the awards. U9 & 11 shall have their Awards presented on Fridays or Saturdays. Women will have their Awards presented after their games.

However, all teams and parents are invited to attend the clubrooms on Saturday nights and any functions we hold through year.
